NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Fire District No. 3, in the Township of Hanover, County of Morris, as follows:

- 1. Ursula Leo, Esq. of Laddey, Clark & Ryan, LLP, 60 Blue Heron Road Suite 300, Sparta, New Jersey is hereby appointed as labor investigator for this Board to serve for a term so designated by the Board, and
- 2. Expenditure for said investigator shall be on a fee for services basis and shall not exceed **\$10,000.00** unless authorized by the Board, and
- 3. Notice of this award shall be published in the official newspaper and shall be made available for public inspection.
