### **Re: Additional Parking Lot**

The Board of Fire Commissioners wishes to advise the public that the additional parking lot previously utilized by the United States Postal Service for overflow parking has been closed effective immediately.

Over the course of our month-to-month lease agreement, the United States Postal Service identified several repairs and improvements that would be necessary for the continued use of the property. After careful review and consideration, the Fire District determined that it is not financially feasible to undertake the required repairs at this time. Repairs would be done at the expense of the fire district which were not budgeted for in this year's fiscal budget.

Because the District is unable to address these identified deficiencies and in the interest of ensuring the safety of all individuals utilizing the property, the Board has elected to terminate the lease agreement. This decision was made with public safety as the foremost consideration.

We appreciate the cooperation and understanding of the United States Postal Service and the community. Should conditions change in the future, the District will reevaluate the property and any potential use thereof.
